Dear Senator,

Having heard you speak on the subject of speculation in the commodities markets I am aware that you know too well the damage it is causing our nation and the world. That is the reason I am writing to you today. The purpose of my letter is two fold, first to present an idea that will get the global economy back on a track of strong growth and do it quickly with little or no cost and second to elicit your help in creating an atmosphere that will not only be receptive to the idea but that might actually persuade the President that he must act as public opinion demands it.
